## Adventure Details

**ISPs & Meetings** - Although Faith is a personal journey, and everyone's journey is different, you are not alone. Your Parish Catechists, Sponsors, Friends and Family are here to help. ISP's help meet every family and individual where they are at. Together we will work to set goals to facilitate Faith Formation.

**Registration Process** - Attend a Family ISP Meeting, Complete Registration Paperwork, Pay Material Fee, Provide Baptism and First Communion Certificates for office use.

**Sponsor Report** - Confirmation Candidates must have a Sponsor to help support and guide them through the Confirmation process. Before choosing a Sponsor consider the following:

*Sponsor Requirements:* Must be a 16+ year old devoted Catholic. May not be Candidates' Parent.

*Sponsor Responsibilities:* Be present and supportive to the candidate throughout their process by:

- Sharing personal faith experiences, Bible reflections and Catholic teachings with Candidate.
- Supporting candidate with Prayer and a Catholic life of discipleship after the Confirmation.
- Being present at Church events, Confirmation Rehearsal and Confirmation day.

*Sponsor Report:* Write a report about why you chose your Sponsor. Some ideas to include are:

Why they like being Catholic, Who their Confirmation Saint was, What are their favorite Scriptures, How do they practice a faithful Catholic Faith, When have they felt God's presence in their life, How do you hope they will improve your Faith, Why did you ask them to be your Sponsor...

**Saint Report** - Each Confirmation Candidate should choose a Saint who inspires them. You will be Confirmed by that Saint's name, to be your Patron. Here are some steps to help choose:

1. *Pray:* "Holy Spirit guide me in choosing a saint who is best for me."
2. *Research:* <http://www.catholic.org/saints/>
3. *List:* Favorites who share your: personality, interests, stories, name, dates-
4. *Narrow:* Chose one you look up to and want to emulate?

*Saint Report:* Prepare a short presentation to share with a group or on social media about the life of your Saint. Include why and how they became a Saint and why you feel a connection with them. Be sure to have a visual that represent them or their life.

**Bishop Letter** - Each Candidate for Confirmation is required to write a 1 page personal letter to the Bishop of Monterey expressing the following:

- Candidates desire and reasons for wanting to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation
- Candidates feelings of how the preparation process has changed/helped them
- Candidates plans of how they will continue to live as a Confirmed Catholic
- Candidates name and Signature

**Book / CD Report** - Write a minimum of 1 page: front and back, single spaced report on a Catholic book, CD or Bible story giving a brief summary and how it has helped you progress toward an ISP goal.

**Service Opportunities** - Be creative and take initiative, or wait for texted opportunities.

**Minister at Mass** - Contact the Parish office to sign up for Lectoring, Ushering or Altar Serving. Or speak with Choir Directors to join a Music ministry.

**Study Series** - Mark your calendars now so you can commit and complete a series.

October - "*Masterpiece*" the study of the Truth, Goodness and Beauty of you!

November - "*Soul Food, Thank You*" the story of the Eucharist.

January - "*Common Thread*" tools to reading the Bible with understanding.

February - "*Tips for Relationships*" the series that helps focus your heartfelt intentions.

March - "*Sent for Barley Cake*" the study of the Amazingly Biblical and Relevant Catholic Mass.

April - "*Sorry, Not Sorry*" intro series to Catholic Apologetics and Controversial Social Topics.
